We organise regular meetings and individual interviews with participants in order to properly monitor the progress of the internship.

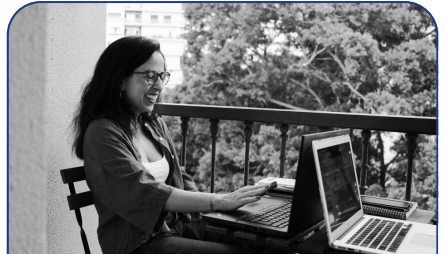

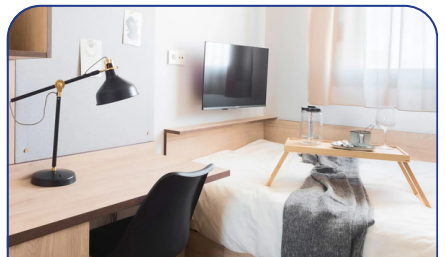

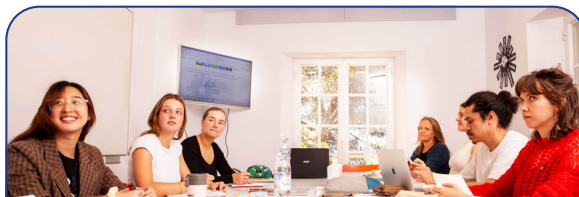

Pre-arrival roadmap

At European Era, we focus on ensuring a successful internship for each participant. Our detailed approach to coordinating group mobility ensures that all aspects are thoroughly reviewed and approved before participants' arrival.

That means that before participants arrive, we dedicate significant resources to ensure that everything is properly organized. To enable this process, we kindly ask participating organizations to provide the following information:

Erasmus+ Project Reference Number: This unique identifier allows us to align our processes with the specific Erasmus+ project, ensuring seamless integration and compliance.

Check-In and Check-Out Dates: Accurate scheduling is key to a smooth experience. Knowing the arrival and departure dates enables us to make the necessary arrangements and ensure participants' comfort throughout their stay.

Flight Information: To ensure timely reception and departure, we request arrival and departure flight details.

Student Information: We value the individuality of each participant. To tailor the internship experience, we require personal details, area of study, course details, and academic level. Additionally, providing CVs helps us match participants with suitable placements.

In addition to all of this, we will send a link to all students to gather more information about their professional profiles. The more detailed the information we receive from each student, the easier it will be for us to find the most suitable company based on their skills.

Once we have all the information, we send a proposal of companies where students can complete their internships. Upon acceptance of the proposal, we dispatch a personalised document to each student, which we refer to as the Individual File. In this file, students can access all the relevant information about the company where they will carry out their internship.

The next phase of the process begins when students arrive in Málaga. During this stage, the entire European Era team is dedicated to ensuring that every student feels supported throughout their mobility.

We provide 24/7 emergency assistance to ensure students always have someone to contact whenever they need help. Below, you'll find a detailed overview of the journey, from airport arrival to the first day at their internship placement.

Upon arrival at the airport, a driver will be waiting in the departure hall with a sign displaying your school's name (where all the drivers are located). We will also monitor your transportation to ensure a smooth arrival.

The driver will take you to your accommodation, where assistance will be provided for check-in and to ensure that everyone settles in comfortably.

Induction Meeting: Depending on the arrival time, this meeting will take place on the first or second day. The purpose of this meeting is to:

- Welcome the group and distribute a welcome pack.
 - Provide essential information for the group's entire stay in Malaga.
 - Address any questions or concerns.

Accompanying students to their work placement sites: A member of EuropeanEra will accompany each student to their work placement, guiding them on how to get there and introducing them to their manager and colleagues. It is crucial for students to dress formally to create a positive and professional first impression.

For us, establishing effective communication with the mobility group is essential for ensuring a satisfactory stay. To facilitate this, we provide two options:

- The designated teacher can receive information from us and then convey it to the entire group.
- We can create a WhatsApp group that includes all students and staff members from our company, enabling continuous and efficient communication in a user-friendly manner.

Accommodation Options

1. Student Residences

This kind of accommodation provides a variety of single rooms and studios, each featuring private bathrooms, refrigerators, WiFi connectivity, and adjustable air conditioning (warm/cold).

With a range of amenities and shared areas, these lodgings are meticulously designed to cater to your every requirement, whether it's for studying, working, or leisurely pursuits.

Located in the heart of Málaga, they offer convenient access to all that the city has to offer.

- Spacious and well-lit coworking rooms, isolated from noise and fully equipped with desks and chairs.
- Option of half or full board.

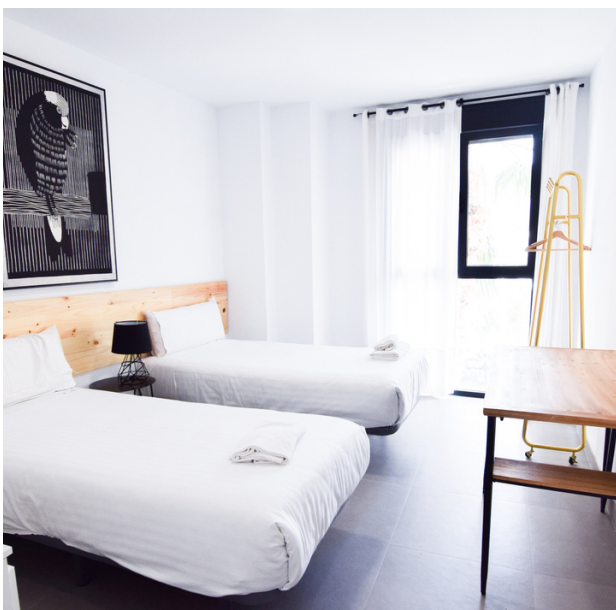
2. Shared apartments

There are different types of shared apartments, all of them located in the citycenter:

- 3 apartments for up to 6 people each: 2 bedrooms, bathroom, living room, and kitchen.
- 3 apartments for up to 5 people each: 2 bedrooms, bathroom, living room, and kitchen.
- 3 studio apartments for up to 2 people each: Studio apartment with kitchen.
- 2 apartments for up to 6 people each: 2 bedrooms, bathroom, living room, and kitchen.

Services

- Wi-Fi connectivity.
- Sheets and towels (1 set per person per stay, change as agreed upon).
- Shared terrace.
- Services and utilities.
- Basic kitchenware and utensils.
- Independent access through numeric codes.
- Specially attractive pricing for groups and students.
- Catering arrangements possible.



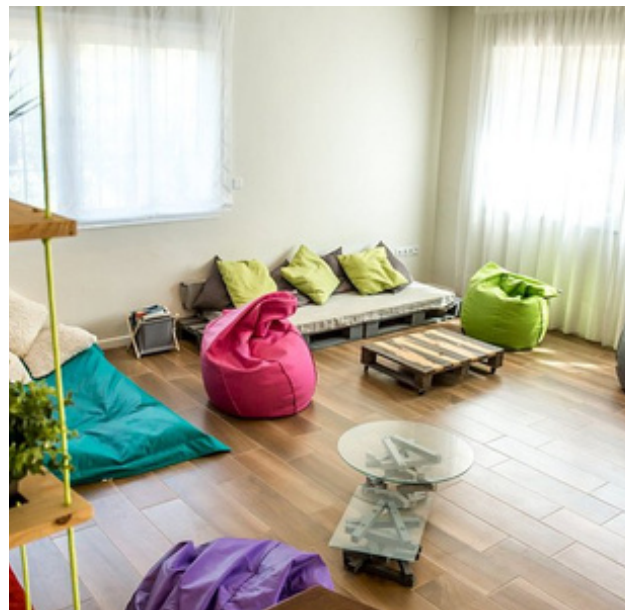
Accommodation Options

3. Buildings for student groups

We offer the option for students to stay in buildings adapted to accommodate student groups. With common areas, shared bathrooms, the choice of shared rooms with bunk beds or private rooms, both doubles and singles. Option of half or full board available.

Services

- Meal Service: Adapted to each group's schedule, they offer breakfast, lunch, and dinner, as well as coffee, water, and infusions throughout the day.
- Laundry Service: Once a week, each student will be able to benefit from this service, which is available from Monday to Thursday, distributed by rooms and coordinated by the staff.
- Cleaning service: Once a week, room cleaning and changing of sheets and towels are carried out. Bathrooms and common areas are cleaned daily.
